The Pat Behler Call-to-Conference Award is sponsored by the Youth Services Community of Interest (YSCI) of the Missouri Library Association.

What is it? An award of financial assistance to attend the Missouri Library Association's Annual Conference and YSCI programs, given to introduce working librarians to the activities and programs of MLA and YSCI and to encourage involvement and ongoing participation in the professional activities of MLA and YSCI.

Who is eligible? Anyone who is currently working as a librarian with a major responsibility for serving children in any library in Missouri and who has not previously attended a Conference. A Master's degree in Library/Information Science is preferred but not required. Preference will be given to applicants from outside the local conference site area.

What will be awarded? Payment to cover first-time MLA membership dues (if applicable), conference registration fees, Thusnelda Schmidt lecture and meal expenses, and an autographed copy of one of the presenter's books.
