Activities:

Monster Says - The rules are the same as "Simon Says", but you are following directions so that Dennis the Monster won't eat you!



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Playdough Monsters - Give each child a circle of playdough to squish into a shape on the table. Then provide googly eyes, foam teeth, straws for arms and legs and let them create their own playdough monster! As an extension, you can roll a dice to see how many of each item they need to use on their monster to practice counting.

Monster Slime Sensory Writing Tray - Mix paint, soap, and glitter into a shallow tray and sprinkle some googly eyes around the edge. Use the open space to practice writing letters, words, or numbers.



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
